

This Deed made the 19th day of January in the year 1854 / Between Nelson B Coleman
 & Almira C Coleman his wife of the One part, and Morris Gillespie & Robert Gillespie of the
 other part: Witnesseeth. That said parties of the first part in consideration of an Eighty Acres
 U S Land Warrant this day transferred, and of One hundred Dollars to be paid on the 25th
 day of December 1854, do grant unto the said parties of the second part, a certain tract or
 parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Kanawha Virginia being the same conveyed
 to said Nelson B Coleman by Jacob Pinion & wife by deed bearing date on the 7th day of October
 1853, and before that conveyed by Jos Pitcher & wife to said Jacob Pinion by deed bearing
 date on the 22nd of April 1841 and recorded in the Clerks Office of Kanawha County on
 Book No - 52 to which reference is hereby made for a more particular description of said
 Land. And the said parties of the first part, do hereby warrant Generally the property hereby
 conveyed ~ And a lien is hereby retained on said Land to secure the payment of said sum of
 One hundred Dollars ~ Witness the following Signatures & Seals
