BURIED HERE

The remains of Samuel Matthews, Sr., who died last Tuesday at Slatington, arrived in Catasaugua on Saturday afternoon and were removed Fairview Cemetery by Undertaker Erdman, where services were held in the chapel, followed by interment in the family plot. The services conducted by Rev. Newton, pastor of the Welsh Congregational Church, Slatington, assisted by Rev. David R. Griffith of this place. Several Welsh hymns were sung by the Slatington choir, the members of which accompanied the cortege to Catasauqua. The late Mr. Matthews was for many years a resident of this place, having been employed at the Catasauqua Rolling Mills. He was one of the oldest members of Catasauqua Lodge No. 269, I. O. O. F., and the Odd Fellows' ritualistic service was conducted at the grave by the officers of the local lodge.
