I shall try to give the home address of each donor for the year 1935 with the address of each family recorded. Information: James Moore born in N.Y. died in Madison, Wisc. came to Wisconsin in 1855, settled at Lone Rock, Wisc., Richland Co. where he lived until death; Nelson Moore his youngest son was 6 months old when he came to Wisc. the 2nd. time, making Nelson Moore b. N.Y. State. James lived on a farm 4 miles from Lone Rock, which is close to Gotham, where Nelson Moore makes his home at this date (1935) age 80 yrs.. He came to The Moore Reunion on Aug. 11, 1935, held at Crotch Lake, near Sturgis, Mich., to meet with the Levi Moore branch of the Moore's of whom he never had seen previously, coming with his daughter Alice Moore Jaquish, and husband Orrin Jaquish both of Excelsior, Wisc., where he runs a store, also Hettie Bennett-Schmitt, niece of Nelson Moore, and Mrs. Anna Moore wife of Nelson's came also, making 5 descendants of James Moore family attending the reunion. A peculiar circumstance about this Mitchell Moore family was the fact that the relatives in N.Y. or Michigan did not know the whereabouts of the family for more than 65 years, all record was lost of them, and until the compiler started the long trail of hunting his ancestors, was anything known of James Moore or Mitchell Moore, only that they came west in many years ago, and tradition said "Lone Rock, Wisconsin" where the compiler found the James Moore decendants liveing in Richland Co. Wisc. The eldest decendants being a son of James Moore-Nelson Moore--b. 1855, living at Gotham, Wisc. 1935. Information:- The compiler has diligently searched for the parents of Enoch Moor--b. Dec. 14, 1768. and the records seem to be a closed book, as far as direct data is concerned. At this time I will introduce records to show the connecting evidence of the Thomas Moor who came from England. 1st. will give data, recently found corroborating tradition and records found in Family Bibles, Historical records, Monumental data, & Tradition, from various sources.

In this evidence 1st. submitted, I will show by other evidence, which was introduced in 1901, to show the connection of the Moore family with the Thomas Moore's lines, besides regular data found in family records. It seems that some of the descendants of the Thomas Moor were trying to make a showing of heirship to some estate claimed to be the estate of Thomas Moore in England.

I will give letter written in 1901, by a lawyer in Lansing, Mich. Albert DeCamp, who is now deceased, to a Mr. Lockwood in N.Y. City, who was supposed to represent some of the Moore descendants in their legal matter of the Thomas Moor estate.

(INFORMATION;- This lawyer DeCamp was always known to the writer as being a cousin of the Moore family in Michigan, just how was never known by the writer, but the letters almost prove the connecting link.) The data by Fred E. DeCamp lawyer, Lansing, Mich., 110 N. Logan st. who is nephew of Albert DeCamp, now deceased.

LETTER

A. N. Lockwood
New York City, N.Y.

Lansing Mich. Feb. 8, 1901

Dear Sir;-

In regards to the Moore heirship matter, and referring further to our talk of last evening we venture to offer the following suggestions,

We understand that Joseph Moore, brother and next to kin, of Thomas Moore, had five children; Joseph, Ruben, Gretchen, Rachel & Jessie Moore Rachell, married Ezekiel DeCamp and they had six children that died leaving heirs, Enoch, Elizabeth, Catherine, Mary, Pender & Ruben DeCamp.

We represent by arrangements with the different heirs, any interest of Enoch DeCamp, in the estate of his mother, Rachel Moore-DeCamp. We have evidence in hand to show birth, marriage, and death of Ezekiel DeCamp and Rachel Moore-DeCamp and evidence of the descent of each of the living heirs, of Enoch DeCamp. The arrangement rests-now in correspondence with the several heirs, but contracts and power of Atty, can be obtained from each as soon as it may become important.

In regards to the heirs of Elizabeth DeCamp we know nothing except that she lived in New York City, married Christian Stammler, and we understand left at least one son and one daughter.

Regarding the heirs of Catherine DeCamp who married a Baker, we have no information. Mary DeCamp, we understand married a Patten, and there is at least one son, David J. Patten, who's residence is probably at Jamacia, New York.

Regarding Pender DeCamp, we understand that he left three sons, of whom two are living and one dead, but represented by heirs, One of these sons, is B.F. DeCamp or Stamford, Conn., yet living. Of the heirs of Ruben DeCamp we have no knowledge.

Letter Continued

There seems to have been some considerable effort made to locate an estate in England, in which Rachel Moore-DeCamp is interested in as niece of Thomas Moor. We have no information as to how much progress has been made in the matter, but it seemed to have lacked the concerted efforts of organization and concentration of effort which is necessary in an affair of this kind.

We suggest that a committee be formed of one person representing the heirs of each of the six children of Rachel Moore-DeCamp, to look over the ground and decide on a further plan of action. This is easy to be done if each family can agree upon a member for such a committee. We ourselves are in a position to speak for the family of Enoch DeCamp, one of us will act upon such a committee and will carefully look after any part of the necessary work, that may be intrusted to us, in any plan of action to be agreed on."

It seems there are three points to be first considered. Is there any such estate to be divided? Was Rachel Moore interested in such estate, and can that fact be proved by legal evidence.? As the interest of all of the children of Rachel Moore-DeCamp were identical and mutual, it seems that any information regarding the matter which may have been obtained by any individual heir, should be submitted to, and placed in the hands of such committee, for the common good, of all. However as a matter of fairness and equity, any actual expenses that have been already incurred in obtaining such information, should be paid for out of the common fund.

We understand from you that the heirs of Pender DeCamp would be represented on such a committee. We do not know how many heirs there were of Mary Patten, but suggest that you see if F. Udolphus Patton of Jamacia, Long Island, New York as he has already very kindly and with considerable trouble looked into the matter, perhaps the arrangements could easily be made that he could serve on such a committee, representing all of the heirs of Mary Patton. If that could be done, three of the six interested would then be interested represented. As we said before, of the other three we have no knowledge at all, but think they could be easily interested if their eyes are open, to their own interest.

Now regarding the interests of the brothers and sisters of Rachel Moore such a committee as we suggest could then appoint one person to act jointly with a representative from each family of the Moore families and all heirships from Joseph Moore, be taken up in a bunch or the heirships of Rachel Moore, be taken up separately, leaving those of her brothers and sisters to look out for themselves.

We understand from our conversation with you that you have no direct interest in the matter yourself, but are kindly looking after the matter and wish to arrange a basis for concerted action by the families, particularly in the interest of your cousin B.F. DeCamp of Stamford conn. The plan we have outlined is only made as a suggestion and we hope will meet the approval of the various interests involved. We had considerable experience in handling some similar matters and are positive that the only way anything can be done is by concerted action.

However, we are rather new to this matter and would not ask or insist on our ideas, but defer to the judgement of those who have already looked into the matter, and join in any feasible plan for pushing the matter along.

In the absense of any concerted plan, however, we do not care to use any time or effort or money, on the matter, knowing that if there is any estate to be divided and any division made and anything paid to any heirs. The heirs of Enoch Moore-DeCamp will have had the matter all arranged for them, and without any problem of expense take our share of the scrap. This is not however, our desire, we desire to -----?

After reading the DeCamp & Lockwood letter, and recalling the fact. That Peter Moore (H.G.M.' father) always said to his family that Ezekiel DeCamp living at Ovio, Clinton Co, Mich. (Banker) was a cousin of the Moore family, the following data will give much light upon the statement. "The DeCamp family are cousins of the Moore's." The compiler will proceed to give record of the DeCamp family.

No doubt a descendant of Thomas Moore of Southold, N.Y. on Long Island, which there is very much data concerning, this Thomas Moore, his parents came from England about 1635, dates, Thomas Moor & Ann Moor, Southold Town records give much data, H.G. Moore 1340 Roosevelt Ave, Lansing, Mich. has many records that have been copied from various sources, which indicate the family lines passing through Salem, Mass. Southold L.I. Orange Co. Noting this record, the compiler sees in it a family connection, but just how, I am unable to tell. The name Lebbaus is not so common as I find, this name and one other being all I ever saw in my tracings, and they both are in the Moore lines and seem very significant of relationship as I will attempt to show at this time.

I lack the evidence, but certainly believe that Sally Moore & Paul Moore were related, perhaps cousins. Sally Moore was the daughter of Dea Wilmot Moore & Azubah Knapp, Dea Wilmot Moore--b. 1769. Enoch Moore--b. Dec. 14, 1768. where is not known to my records. This David Moore, was parent of Dea Wilmot Moore and may have been parent of Enoch Moor. In the records of the Moore lines, the Knapp family is again introduced in the lines in Wisconsin, and George W. Moore of Los Angeles, says that when he was young, he often heard his folks speak about the Knapp's and some of them were in N.Y. State. On the property map of Orange Co. N.Y. this date, appears the names of Knapps which live in the county showing location of their farms at this date, also Moore's-Horton's-Wickham's and many others that come into the family lines. I have given some of the names that show family connections, such as Lebbaus, Enoch and I will give a few more to show, where the family were at certain dates.
