Dr. Jack Schaffer, a descendant of Edmund's, writes: "In terms of the 1850 census record, . . . No one in my family knows who those people are! My great grandmother was Frances and my mother and my grandmother knew all of the kids listed in the 1840 census, which I uploaded, except Patrick Fisher, who, it turns out, was a nephew of Edmund's. . . . When we first found that [1850] census record, my grandmother was still alive.
