Bible and various loose pages of correspondence

**Original author:** James Montgomery Perkins

**Kinship to source:** Granduncle of Florence

**Common ancestor:** Hiram Perkins Sr.  
Florence's great-grandfather  
James M. Perkins' father

**Item description:** (undated) List of siblings and parents of James M. Perkins written in James' own hand, presumed a letter or an enclosure with a letter. The list concludes with "Yours truly, Your brother J. M. Perkins". In several locations is what appears to be a salutation that reads "Gust." This suggests the possibility the letter was written to his brother Hiram Augustus Perkins, who was commonly referred to as "Gus".  
The best estimate on when the document was created would be no later than 1894, the year of Gus's death, and probably in the 1880's.  
The original letter was on lined stationery and written in light ink. A clear reproduction is not possible.
