

REV. W. C. ARCHER DEAD.

**Lecturer and Writer Passes Away in
Kansas City.**

Kansas City, Mo., Aug. 3.—The Rev. William C. Archer, lecturer and writer and a member of the Ministerial alliance, of New York city, died here today at the home of his daughter, Mrs. William M. Campbell. He had been prominent in Baptist missionary work in the middle west for nearly sixty years. He was born in Newcastle, Ireland, 75 years ago. He has charge of churches in New York, Washington and Denver and cities in Kansas, Colorado and Illinois. A son and a daughter, Harold Larcher and Mrs. B. C. Berriam, live in Denver; a son, R. O. Archer, in San Francisco and a daughter, Miss Cecile Jacqueline Archer, resides in New York city.
