According to Plymouth, Mass., records, John Finney was in that town as early as 1630 with his mother, his brother Robert, and his sister Catherine. Tradition has it that the father died while crossing the sea. No definite information has been found as to the boat upon which they arrived or their place of birth in England. Some investigators claim that the family came from Wales and others that they were from Pontypool in Monmouthshire, a county which once belonged to Wales but was taken over by Henry VIII to become a part of England early in the 16th century.

John Finney's mother, who is referred to only as "Mother Finney," died in Plymouth, April 22, 1650, "age upwards of 80 years." His brother Robert was born about 1608 and died Jan. 7, 1687; he married Phebe Ripley, who was born about 1619 and died Oct. 9, 1710, in her 92nd year. They had no children. John's sister Catherine married Gabriel Fallowell.

John Finney probably lived in Plymouth for several years; his two sons by his first wife were born there. He next moved to Barnstable, Mass., where seven of his children were born, and eventually to Bristol, R. I. He had seven sons. The eldest, John², Jr., settled in Barnstable and founded what is known as the Barnstable branch of the family; his descendants have usually spelled their surname "Phinney." Josiah² made his home in Plymouth and thus established the Plymouth line. Jonathan², Jeremiah², and Joshua² all went to Rhode Island with their father, and their descendants form the so-called Bristol branch. The Phinney spelling is sometimes found in the Plymouth and Bristol lines also, especially in the later generations.
