Emma Holdaway was born in Lasham, Hampshire, England on or around 15 April 1832. She was the second child, and only daughter of John Holdaway and his wife Mary, formerly Mary Norgate.

When Emma was ten years of age, her parents and others from Lasham and nearby areas decided to seek a new and better life in New Zealand. Life was very difficult for the ordinary folk in England at that time, and the newly formed New Zealand Company offered opportunities in a new land just being settled and developed. John Holdaway and other men set sail for New Zealand on the vessel "Whitby" from Gravesend on 27 April 1841. It was intended that they went ahead to prepare for the arrival of their wives and families on a later ship.

Emma, together with her mother Mary, and three brothers William, 12, George, 8 and James, 5, sailed from West India Dock on board "Mary Ann" on 24 September 1841, together with the wives and families of the other men who had sailed on the "Whitby", and were to disembark in Nelson on 7 February 1842. It had been a difficult journey, as Emma's mother Mary gave birth to another son during the voyage. The baby died and Mary was left very ill.

This voyage must have been hard for the ten year old Emma. Mary had apparently been unwell for most of the journey. She was certainly still in very poor health after the birth of the baby son. Emma was the only daughter, and two of her brothers were younger than herself. The other women would certainly have helped all they could, but much of the responsibility of keeping her brothers safe and out of mischief in the cramped conditions of the vessel would have fallen on her young shoulders.

Even the arrival at Nelson and their reunion would not have been the joyful event that it should have been. Her father, John, would have been greeted by a frail wife with the news of a baby son he had never seen, living and dying during the voyage. Mary's friend, Amelia Cresswell, was greeted with the news that her husband, Thomas Cresswell, had died of typhoid fever within two weeks after reaching Nelson, and that she was a widow in a strange land.

When the new arrivals came ashore in Nelson, near Haulashore Island, they would have had to walk up the very steep hill to the Customs Station on Britannia Heights to complete formalities. Can you picture this scene? Mary, and the others, still not yet accustomed to land under their feet again, hampered by the clothing of those days, struggling up the steep near-cliffs to the Customs Station. It was February, so probably a very hot day. They would have had to carry as much as possible, as there was no transport. Women wore long skirts, many petticoats, tight bodices, and bonnets. The paths would have been rough, and with native trees and bushes in their way. Emma would have had to assist her mother and younger brothers. On completion of formalities the family, with the other new arrivals would then have had to trek down the steep hill on the far side, down through the flax, undergrowth and swampy areas of Washington Valley, across the wooded flats and on to the rise of land where the Nelson Cathedral now stands.

The home to which Emma and her family came was a very makeshift one, but the best that her father could provide at the time. It was made, as were other homes then, of manuka poles, thatched with raupo and lined with sailcloth to keep out draughts and as much of the rain as possible. There were no amenities - no toilet, no laundry, no running water, no bathroom, and of course, they were highly flammable. Cooking was done outside with pots and later camp ovens. Large rats were a constant problem, and invaded these makeshift homes freely, day and night.

Life was hard in those early days, and Emma's mother, already frail from the birth and death of her latest son at sea, became steadily weaker and died a scant four months later on 9 May 1842. She is believed to have been buried a little higher up on the rise above the Cathedral (perhaps in Fairfield Park where later settlers were buried) but no record or stone exists to mark the site.

Emma's father asked Amelia Cresswell to be his housekeeper, but she firmly declined. Soon afterwards however, they were married, on 7 August 1842. Emma was suddenly part of a

larger family, as Amelia had four children: William 6, Elizabeth 4, Mary 2, and Charles 3 weeks old when they had sailed from England.

In 1843 the Wairau Massacre caused great panic among the Nelson settlers. Fearing that they would be the next to be attacked, all labourers, including John Holdaway, were ordered to hurriedly build a fortress on the Cathedral site. Unfortunately, in their haste the gentry had designed a fortress too small to hold everyone, so the gentry occupied the fortress while the labourers and their families took their chances outside. It is believed that this prompted John Holdaway to take his family and "squat" on clear land in the Maitai Valley. John must have been fairly sure by this time that they were not going to be attacked, as the Maitai Valley was on the route used by both the Maori and settlers, whenever travelling overland to the Wairau Valley. John built a home on the area known as Almond Tree Flat. Probably this is the area now known as Waahi Taakaro and occupied by the Golf Club. John was a hardworking man and soon had many improvements for his family. He grew vegetables and acquired some animals. In 1848 a Census of all living in the Nelson-Waimea areas describes him as a dairyman, which meant that he was able to sell farm produce. John and Amelia had eleven more children, so no doubt Emma, as the oldest girl in the family, was kept busy helping her stepmother.

In 1851 John Holdaway moved his family to a fifty acre property on the corner of Champion Road and Main Road, Stoke. Officially in early records it was recorded as freehold land in Waimea East, being Section 69. The house there, near the corner of the two roads, was described as a substantial two-storied house with dormer windows, shingle roof, and a long covered verandah. Emma's lifestyle had certainly improved in nine years of living in New Zealand.

On 17 March 1851, at the age of nineteen, Emma was married to Robert Edward Oscar de Bruce by Rev. Samuel Ironside. Their marriage lines describe him as a bachelor of 21 years, but at present no more is known of him.

At Emma's re-marriage in 1859 she is described as a widow, although no details of Robert de Bruce's death have been found. Emma's second marriage was to James Hay Taylor who arrived in Nelson on or about 12 July 1850 on the barque "Poitiers", having sailed from London on 8 February that year. He is described on the ship's manifesto as single, aged 29 years and a farm servant. There were apparently three men by the name of James Taylor living in Nelson and Stoke in the following ten to twenty years, and it is difficult to be sure which was 'our' James in later years. James Taylor's name appears in the 1865-67 Electoral Rolls as owning freehold land at Stoke, part of Section 59. He was also listed as a Constable at Richmond from 1854-1868. This fact is borne out in the death notice in 1918 of their son-in-law, Philip Fissenden (who married their daughter Elizabeth Emma), which states "... married a daughter of Constable Taylor, Nelson ...". It is almost certain that 'our' James was the James Taylor who died on 22 January 1868, aged 48 years. The age fits with his age on arriving in New Zealand, and also explains why Emma, on her death on 19 September 1913 at the age of 83, was described as "housekeeper of Thomas Brown". One of Emma's daughters, Isabella, married Bill (William) Brown, the youngest son of Thomas Brown.

Emma had five children that we are sure of: Elizabeth Emma born 27 March 1855, James born in 1857, Alice born 6 April 1860, Annie born 1863, Mary (known as Polly), and Isabella. There appears to have been another child whose death is recorded in the Richmond cemetery as Taylor, son of James H Taylor, died August 1866, aged one and a half years. All the children grew up with the surname Taylor.

In recording the next generation down from Emma and James Taylor we begin with Elizabeth Emma. She married Philip Fissenden, a widower with three sons.

Philip Fissenden came to New Zealand in 1874 on the ship "Hannibal" with his three sons, Sydney, then aged 5, Philip, 4 and Walter, 2. Also on the same ship were his cousin John Fissenden and two of his sisters Eliza Emily Oben with her husband Henry, and Emily Day with

her husband Joseph Day and small son Arthur. Philip's wife Ann Masters had died just before sailing from England, so his two sisters suddenly acquired extra "sons" to make it possible for Philip to bring his family to New Zealand. They landed in Nelson, where Philip left his three sons in the care of his sisters, while he soon moved across to Marlborough, or Wairau Valley as it was then called. Where and how Philip Fissenden and Elizabeth Emma Taylor met, is not clear. Perhaps Philip met her during visits back to his sisters in Nelson to see his sons. Perhaps they met when Elizabeth Emma Taylor came to Wairau Valley to visit her sister Alice who married Edward Guest, and appears to have been in Marlborough by then. Elizabeth Emma Taylor married Philip Fissenden on 12 August 1880 as recorded in the Register of the Nativity Church, Blenheim. That register contains all marriages in the Church of England in Marlborough at that time, both in Blenheim and in the Awatere Valley, so it is not clear whether they were married in Blenheim as we had always supposed, or in Seddon. By this time Philip was working on the Starborough Estate in Seddon. In his obituary, as printed in "The Colonist" 1857 - 1920, it states:

"27th July, 1918, Philip Fissenden, Blind River, aged 75. Arrived Hannibal, 1874, then a widower with three sons. Left them with married sisters in Nelson and went to Marlborough Station (Starborough). During his 9 years there married daughter of Constable Taylor, Nelson. Leaves widow, six sons and six daughters. One son, Philip Fissenden is a settler in Ward."

This does not fit timewise, with his leaving to take up farming in Blind River. The Atkinson Estate, also called Blind River Estate, was cut up into smaller settlements in 1895. In 1896 Philip Fissenden bought Section 5 from a Mr J Hall. It had a house on it, built on a low river flat where it was sheltered from the prevailing nor'west winds. This proved to be in danger of flooding in the winter, so a bigger home was built just above on the higher terrace. In 1897 he acquired the sections on either side of him, Section 4 from Mr Bob Morrow, and Section 6 from Mr Breayley.

My father, Philip and Elizabeth's second son Frederick (Bob) often told the story of the move from Starborough to Blind River. All their belongings were loaded on a flat-deck wagon and Philip and Elizabeth and most of their then eight children on top, set off down through the Hog Swamp valley to Blind River, then downstream to their property. The older son, Frank James, and a female school teacher rode with them on riding horses, and a milk cow was tied to the back of the wagon.

Elizabeth Emma and Philip Fissenden had eleven children; Annie who married Norman Catley; Frank James; Emma Alice; Ellen Isabella who married Ernest Langridge; Louisa who married Cyril Walker; Elizabeth Emma who married George Allen; Frederick (Bob) who married Violet Coward; Jack who married Trixie Coward; Pearl who married Bill Merrifield; Kate who married George Thompson; and Gladys who married Gilbert Beach.

The three older sons of Philip Fissenden, left with Philip's sisters in Nelson, often visited their father and new family, but only Philip seems to have kept close contact in later years. By the time Philip and Elizabeth moved to Blind River, the three older boys would have been Sydney, 28, Philip, 27 and Walter, 24.

Elizabeth and Philip's second son, Frederick (my father) married Violet Coward on 28 July 1926 and moved to his own farm at Cannibal Cove in the Queen Charlotte Sounds, where they farmed in an isolation that must have resembled the isolation of their earlier forebears. Imagine no electricity, only cold running water, having to make their own bread, cure their own meat, and be almost fully self-contained. When they went there a mail launch called twice-weekly, and took the cream from a herd of 40 cows to the dairy factory at Linkwater. But the Depression years soon came, and the mail launch was cut back to once a fortnight in summer and once a month in winter. They had no refrigeration so were forced to make all the cream into separator

butter by hand, and sell it through E G Berry's Grocery in Picton, where it found a ready market at four pence per pound (3 cents per 500 grams). They also ran one thousand breeding ewes on the steep, difficult Sounds hillsides. During those difficult Depression years many a young cousin or nephew would spend a year or two at Cannibal Cove working with my father in return for their keep and maybe a few quid when they left to return to their own homes. Their help was invaluable to my father, helping to milk cows, and keep the scrub clearing work in hand - a constant task in that kind of country. It must also have been of great benefit to their parents to have one mouth less to feed for families without work or insufficient work in a time when redundancies or unemployment benefits had not been thought of.

My parents had three daughters, June (myself), Betty and Faye. We had all our early schooling by correspondence, a wonderful system of schooling for backblock children. In 1940 we left the Sounds and went back to Blind River where my father and his older brother Frank James, ran the original family property in partnership until Frank died on 24 December 1948. My father stayed on the property until he had to retire in 1954, when it was sold; the first time the land had been out of the family since it had been purchased in 1896/7. Part of the original homestead still stands where Philip and Elizabeth lived all those years ago.

Emma and James Taylor had other children whose histories I do not know so well. Alice was born on 6 April 1860 and died 23 August 1938. She married Edward Guest on 30 June 1879 and had eight children: Arthur Edward who married Minnie Adams; William James who married Elizabeth Burns McIntosh; Edith Emma who married Charles Binning; Amy; Norman Coleman who married Ida Chapman; Muriel Grace (called Molly); Hubert Stanley who married Gwen Congdon; Alan Howard who married Eva Smith; and Nancy Gaukrodger. Alice and Edward lived in later years in Picton.

Annie was born 30 December 1863 and died in 1944. She married Charles Edwin Stratford, and had nine children: Maude who married John Thomas and Thomas Cooney; Harter; Victor who married Jennie Fisher; Hilda who died aged 2 years; Norman who married Eva Mary Bateup; Kate who married Alfred Henry Davy; Violet; Roy who married Dulcie Evelyn Stratford; and Pearl who married Sydney George Chandler. Annie and Charles lived in Nelson.

Mary (Polly) married John Victor Edwards. They had six children: Eva Emma who married Alfred Freeth; Maud Isabell who married James Charles Webb; Daisy who married J Barnard; Olive who married W H Nash; Ella Hilda who married Claude Henry Alborough and James Ryan; and Ethel who married Alec D Page.

Isabella married William (Bill) Brown, and lived in Nelson, at one time at The Port. There are records of various births and deaths of "Browns" who lived at The Port, but none are clearly children of this marriage.

The life of their son James is difficult to trace with certainty. Family tradition has always had it that "Uncle James" was drowned while trying to cross the swollen Awatere River on horseback. But "Uncle James" could be either James Taylor or James Fissenden, who was a young cousin of Philip Fissenden of whom there is no other trace after his arrival in New Zealand at Nelson. There is no further record to date of either James except a photograph believed to be James Taylor as a young man.

Most of this story can be proved from various records in the Nelson Museum Archives, Church of England Archives in Nelson, and Books such as "Landfall Nelson" by June Neale, "The Awatere" by A L Kennington, and others. Some of it is inconclusive, but appears to be correct.
