## TITLE PAGE

The title page, as well as the front cover, gives both the spelling **DETWEILER** and **DETWILER** since both spellings were used by the extended family with several of the descendants of Johannes and Maria (Reiff) Detweiler having dropped the medial "e." The spelling of family names used in this history is that given by either some members of that extended family, as used on tombstones, or given in other family genealogies—sometimes varying from one family history to another. However, the heading for each child of Johannes and Anna (Reiff) Detweiler will be shown in the original format; namely, Detweiler. Every effort was used to be true to each individual family in the listing of individual family lines.

### ORIGIN OF NAME **DETWILLER, DETWEILER, DETWILER**

**DETWEILER, DETWILER** (Swiss-German): One who came from Datweil, in the Canton Zurich, Switzerland.

The names **DETWILLER**, **DETWEILER**, **DETWILER**, **TETWYLER**, **DATWYLER** AND **TITWYLER** are believed to be a derivation of the name of an individual, **DETO**, who in Roman times, built his house in Canton ARUGA, Switzerland, and whose descendants were called by his name and that of his house, i.e. "**DETO-VILLA**" (villa, Latin house). Tradition asserts that while those later bearing the above forms of this name are not descendants of DETO, many of them are descendants of a noble family which came into possession of "Deto's Villa" or Datwyl, as it came to be known in remote time; many families whose surnames are various forms of the above, trace their lineage to very early times and a few of them to the locality of the town of Datwyl. Tuetonic Heraldic Law allows families of similar surnames to bear similar arms, slight variations in blazon being customary. Ref: *Mr. John Detwiller Davis of Easton, Penna. who was in Switzerland where he gained the above information.*

Another source states that the name "**DETTWEILER**" is originally Austrian and had a coat of arms and helmet. In 1300 the Austrian name was spelled "*Detville*" and between 1303 and 1311 there is record of them giving their yearly tribute to the Hapsburgs.

About 1590 a Jacob and George Dettweiller were both in Saget and in Langebruck an. Um around 1600. In 1601 a Henry Dettweiller paid an amount of 480 pounds in penalty for his brother because of their religious beliefs and being accused of baptizing. In 1711 there was man known to be Christen Datwyler in Wittwyl.

Although no information to date has been found stating the birthplace of our immigrant ancestor Hans Detweiler or his wife Susanna, it is hoped that at some further time, this knowledge will be forthcoming.

#### FOURTH GENERATION

According to the *Rosenberger and Swartley Family History*, Jacob was a s/John Rosenberger of Hatfield, grandson of Benjamin who was born in Germany and died about 1777, was married to Helena. Benjamin's father was Henry Rosenberger who came to Franconia from Germany in 1729 and was of the Mennonite faith. [In a *Biographical History of Early Settlers and their Descendants in WATERLOO TOWNSHIP* by Ezra Eby, he states that Jacob was the second s/Abraham Rosenberger, s/Daniel, Jr. who was born about 1744 and first married Anna Funk and after her death to Barbara Detweiler.]

Jacob and Mary (Detwiler) Rosenberger migrated to Canada in 1822 and settled in Waterloo County. In 1834 while residing in Beverly Twp., Wentworth Co., they, along with their sons, Henry and Joseph, contracted cholera and died. Ref: 17, 21

38-2. DETWEILER, ELIZABETH H.<sup>38</sup>, 8 Aug 1784--9 Aug 1856: m. BENJAMIN G. HALLMAN, Perkiomen Twp. 18 Sept 1783--10 Sept 1867(9?), s/Benjamin and Fronica (Gotwals) Hallman and the great grandson of Anthony (1671--July 16, 1739) and Mary Salome Hallman. The family moved to Canada in 1823. According to descendants of Benjamin, his calling was farming but during the depression from 1816 until 1827 many farms failed and in order that their creditors not take a loss, those they made the move to Canada did so at a great personal monetary loss. Benjamin was said to have suffered greatly during the crisis; however, in a very few years most all had prosperous and valuable farms.

Rev. Jacob<sup>38-21</sup> was born in Pennsylvania. In 1822 he set out on foot and walked to Upper Canada, Waterloo County, earning his way as he travelled. He had set out without money. On 21 June 1734 they embarked on the Ship *Andrew* and on 20 July reached Plymouth, England. The new world was first seen by them 17 Sept and they landed in Pennsylvania 22 Sept 1734.
