MARGARET FRY (494),⁷⁷ Fifth child and second daughter of Colonel Joshua and Mary (Micou) Fry was born 15 May, 1744; died 1811; married **JOHN SCOTT** [1] (973), born ; died 1798; son of Edward Scott (3681), who in 1732, patented 550 acres "on the north side of the Fluvanna at a place called Totier."
 John Scott (973), in his will, dated 23 February, 1798, probated July, 1798, mentions his wife, Margaret; children: Daniel, Edward, Charles Alexander, Samuel and Frances (or Francis); grandchild, John Scott; son-in-law, George Nicholas; daughter-in-law, Elizabeth Scott. The executors were: Edward, Charles and Samuel Scott; George Nicholas; John Harris; John Coles; Samuel Pleasants; Samuel Dyer. Witnesses: Charles Wingfield, Joshua Fry, Ben Harris, Robert Logan.
