State of Georgia Coweta County

This Indenture made this Eighth day of January in the year of our Lord
Eighteen Hundred & fifty five Between George Hendrix of said County & State
of the part and Frances Asberry Hendrix James Pinckney Hendrix & Henry
Harrison Hendrix sons of George Hendrix of the same place of the other part
Witnesseth that the said George Hendrix for & in consideration of the natural
love & affection which he has & bears to his said Sons F A Hendrix J P
Hendrix & H H Hendrix hath given, granted & conveyed & does by these
presents give grant & convey unto the Said F A Hendrix J P Hendrix & H H
Hendrix their heirs & assigns all of my Estate to be Equally divided between
my three Sons above named. To have & hold said Estate or parcel of property
unto them the said F A Hendrix J P Hendrix & H H Hendrix their heirs &
assigns together with all & singular the rights members and appertenances to
the Same in any manner belonging to them and their own proper use benefit &
behoof forever in fee Simple.
