- Nov 24 Met in conference agreed to move the place of holding the Meeting - appointed the Brethren Barbree and Pease purchase land to build the Meeting House on, took a quarry. What shall be done with a member who never comes to conference; - agreed that the deacons of the church labour with him.
- Decem. 21 Met in conference recd into fellowship Tracy Anderson appointed Bro. Pierce to write letters of dismission for Christopher Dyess, Joshua Collins, Leace Collins & Sarah Collins.
