To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, *Moses Vanwinkle of Licking County Ohio* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Zanesville* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Moses Vanwinkle* according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the *South West quarter of the North East quarter, of Section one, in Township Four, of Range Ten, of the unappropriated Lands in the Military District subject to Sale at Zanesville Ohio* containing *Thirty three acres, and seventy six hundredths of an acre,* according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Moses Vanwinkle*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Moses Vanwinkle* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said *Moses Vanwinkle* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *Andrew Jackson* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the *Twenty third* day of *September* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty five* and of the Independence of the United States the *Fifty sixth* *Scott*
