## MEMORANDA relating to the POST FAMILY

STEPHEN POST or POSTE came to this country in or prior to the year 1634. His name appears in the records of Newtown, now Cambridge, Mass., in the list of freemen for the year above mentioned. It is a tradition of the family that he came from England, but from what county is not known. The name POST occurs in the records of the County of Kent, as far back as the year 1502. GEORGE POST of ULCOMBE died in that year and had many descendents, among which the name STEPHEN was not uncommon. It is however, only conjectural, to say that STEPHEN POST of Newtown was probably descended from him. A careful search among the lists of emigrants from England to this country, during the first half of the 17th century fails to discover the name of STEPHEN POST. There is nothing strange in this fact. It is well known that many families who were obnoxious to the government on account of their religious or political opinions left England secretly during this period. STEPHEN BOST was doubtless of this class. Soon after his arrival in New England, he left Massachusetts as a member of the congregation of Hooker and Stone, and with them went westward to the site of Hartford, of which place he became one of the proprietors and founders. After a short residence there, he sold his lands in the vicinity and removed to Saybrooke, Conn., where he passed the remainder of his days, and died on the 16th of August, 1659. Four children came to this country with him, JOHN, THOMAS, ABRAHAM and CATHERINE. JOHN and THOMAS were among the founders and original proprietors of Norwich, Conn. STEPHEN POST was undoubtedly a man of substance and influence in the colony. He was a friend of the chieftain UNCAS, and by the will of that sachem received 7000 acres of land in southern Conn., which

devise was afterwards ratified by the Legislature of the colony.

Both tradition and records are silent as to the name of his wife.

She probably died before his emigration.

STEPHEN POST'S children, above mentioned, were infants at the time of his arrival in this country. JOHN was probably the eldest. It appears from the inscription on his tombstone at Nowwich that he was born in the year 1626. In March 1652, he married HESTER, daughter of William Hyde. He died Nov. 27th, 1710, at Norwich, Conn.

THOMAS POST was married twice: first to MARY ANDREWS in January 1656; second to REBECCA, daughter of Obadish Bruen, September 2, 1663. He died in 1701 at Nowrich, Conn.

CATHERINE POST was married September 28, 1749, to ALEXANDER CHALKER. JOHN, THOMAS and CATHERINE each left children.

Our branch of the family is sprung from the other son of STEPHEN, ABRAHAM POST, or, as his name usually appears in the records, ABRAHAM POSTE. We do not know the date of his birth of marriage. His wife's name was MARY. He succeeded to his father's property at Saybrooke, and there lived all his days, dying in the year 1690. He was placed in command of the Saybrooke Fort, as Lieutenant, and was for awhile, the Representative of Saybrooke in the Colonial Assembly. He had eleven children, all born in Saybrooke, as follows:

- STEPHEN, the eldest of the children of ABRAHAM POSTE, was born at Saybrooke, on December 3, 1664. He married HANNAH, daughter of Stephen Hosmer, June 14, 1692. Thereafter he removed from Saybrooke to the vicinity of what is now Hebron, Conn., and went into occupation of a portion of the lands belonging to the family, and which had been devised to STEPHEN POSTE, his grandfather, by the sachem, UNCAS, as is above mentioned. Here he spent his life, and died on May 16, 1752. His wife died before him, on January 25, 1750. Eleven children were the fruit of their marriage, all born at Saybrooke, with the exception of the youngest, RACHEL, who was born at Hebron. They were as follows:

GIDEON POSTE, the sixth child of STEPHEN POSTE of Hebron, and our ancestor, was born at Saybrooke on February 10, 1703. He was married February 20, 1730, to MARY CHASE; at Bolton, Conn. He became the father of ten children, passed his life at Hebron, and died there January 1, 1751. He lies buried in the Gilead Churchyard, near Hebron. His children were as follows:

OLIVER POSTE, youngest of the children of GIDEON POSTE but one, and our ancestor, was born at Hebron, October 21, 1746. In early manhood he left Hebron and made his way northward into Massachusetts. He was twice married. His first wife was ABIGAIL DEAN, daughter of SETH DEAN, of New Marlboro, Mass., and a relative of FAUL DEAN, one of the Revolutionary Envoys of this country of France. He married her at New Marlboro on November 25, 1772. She died September 17, 1773, in giving birth to a daughter, ABIGAIL. On May 26, 1776, he married at Westhampton, Mass., EXPERIENCE SUBMIT, daughter of STEPHEN HOYT of that place. She was born June 13, 1754, at East Gifford, Conn. ABIGAIL, his child by his first wife, died September 22, 1787, at New Marlboro. By his second wife he had seven children, all of whom were born at Westhampton, and were as follows:

He died at Hinesburg, May 3, 1881, aged 87 years and 7
months. His monument stands in the Hinesburg Cemetery,
an association for which he obtained the charter from
the State of Vermont in 1856. MERCY MERINDA, his second
wife, died January 17, 1882, aged 79 years and 7 months.

OLIVER POSTE, after the birth of all his children, removed

(May 1801) from Westhampton, Mass., to Hinesburg, Vt., and there

-passed his life and was there buried, March 10, 1816, aged 76 years.

He saw service in the Revolutionary War, was stationed in a fort

near Wilksbarre, Penn., six months, and fought for his country at the battle of Brandywine, and in other engagements. ALSON HOYT, alone, of all his children, remained in Vermont. OLIVER JR. removed when a young man to St. Lawrence County, N.Y., and there lived and died. The other sons and daughters went still ruther west. ALSON HOYT POST was a man of prominence and great influence in and about Hinesburg; was called upon to represent the Town in the Legislature in 1856 and 1857, and at the extra session of the same after the destruction of the State House by fire; and occupied a position of eminent and honorable respectability.

EXPERIENCE SUBMIT HOYT, wife of OLIVER POSTE SR., went to Bainbridge, Ohio, where she lived with her daughter MERCY BISSELL, for twenty years, and probably left the Family Bible there when she returned to live with her son ALSON HOYT POST, in Hinesburg, Vt., and there died and was buried beside her husband, October 3, 1846, aged 92 years.


