 YOU are hereby commanded that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of Jacob Waggoner if to be found in your bailiwick, you cause to be made the sum of Nine pounds five shillings eight pence — Current Money which in the Superior Court of Law, held for the district of Salisbury at the court-house in Salisbury, John Grove recovered against him for _____ as well as the further sum of _____ for costs and charges in the said suit expended, whereof the said Jacob Waggoner is liable as appear to us of record; besides your fees for this service. And have you the said monies before the Judges of our said court, at Salisbury, on the nineteenth day of September next, then and there to render to the said John Grove for his damages, costs and charges as aforesaid. Herein fail not, and have you then and there this writ.

all of the County of *Rowan* are held and firmly bound unto

Samuel James Sheriff of our said County, in the sum of *one Hundred & sixty dollars & fifty cents* current money of this State: to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this *9th* day of *August* Anno Domini 1822

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bounden *Christian Badenshamer & Jacob Badenshamer* do make their personal appearance before the Justices of the County Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions, to be held for the County of *Rowan* at the Court-House in *Salisbury* on the *third* Monday in *August* next, then and there to answer unto *Jacob Lapp* Executor of *Jacob Wagener* Decd of a plea that they render to him the sum of *Eighty Dollars and fifty cents* which they owe and claim to his Damage *fifty dollars*

and there to abide by the judgment of said Court, and not depart the same without leave first had; then this obligation to be void...else to remain in force and virtue.
