Declaration for Invalid Pension.

State of Kansas County of Wilson ss:

ON THIS 27 day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety one
before me a Notary Public in and for the county

and State aforesaid, personally appeared John M Frankenberg
aged 44 years, a resident of Attouma, county of
Wilson, State of Kansas, who being duly sworn according to

law, declares that he is the identical John M Frankenberg who was enrolled on
the 4 day of January 1864, in Private Co H Regiment No
Ill. Supt
Here state rank, company and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if
in the Navy.

Mobile Alabama, on the 26 day of August 1865

That he is Partly unable to earn a support by reason of Concussion of

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under
the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.
