June '64 reports him present. *July & August '64* absent in
Provisional Camp Fort Pickering, Memphis, Tenn. *September*
& October '64 present. Same report to *June 30 '65*.
 Mustered out with Company *August 26 1865*, at
Mobile, Ala., a *Private*.

(Regt. was engaged in the siege of *Bleakely, Ala.* *March 31* to
April 9 '65.)

Records of this Office furnish no evidence of alleged
 wound or sunstroke. No additional information
 in case.
