Item. I give unto the Child my wife goes with if it be a son as aforesaid seven ty Acres of land called Goldsmiths Inlargement to him his heires or assigns for ever, but if a girl to my daughter Mary her her heires or assigns for ever. Item. I give unto my daughter Mary ffve hundred Acres of land lying at Gunpowder if the Child my wife now goes with be a boy to her her heires and assigns for ever, but if it be a girl my wife now goes with I leave it to the said girl to her her heires and assigns for ever. Item. I give and bequeath as aforesaid ffifty Acres of land lately bought of George Oglesby as aforesaid ffve hundred Acres at Gunpowder. Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Goldsmith two hundred Acres of land called Bonnington lying in Sassafras River to her and her heires for ever. Item. I give unto my said Deare wife Martha Goldsmith one hundred and ffifty Acres lying at the head of Swan Creeke called Robbin Hoods Horroft to her and her heires for ever. Item. I give unto the Child my wife goes with my seale Ring if it be a son, if a girl to my daughter Mary, also one small hoop Ring. I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary. Item. I give unto my beloved wife Martha Goldsmith one moiety of my personall Estate to her and her heires for ever, and the other moiety to my two Children Vizt. my daughter Mary and the Child my wife now goes with. Item. I give unto my brother in law Edward Woodde my Plate buttons I use to weare. Item. I make ordoyne and constitute my deare wife Martha Goldsmith my whole and sole Executrix to see this my last Will and Testament fully performed as witnesses my hand and seale this Thirtenth day March Annoque Domini 1694. Item. if it shall happen that my deare wife that now is should marry againe, and the Children thereby should suffer, my desire is that my brother in law Edward Woodde should take the said Children with their part and portions into his care and tuition, and to see them carefully Educated. Saviour and Redeemer in home and by the meritts of Jesus Christ swift and bolove 75 aswredly to be saved and to have full remission and forgiveness for all my that my soule with my body all the generall day of resurrection / against injury and through the of meritts of Christ death and passion posses and Inheritt the Kingdom of Heaven. prepared for his elect and my body to be buried in such manner as it shall please my Exitt. hereafter whom I shall appoint. And now for the settling of my tommorrell Estate first I desire that all my Just debts that I owe in right to any man shall well and truly paid or ordered to be paid in due time after this my decease by my Exitt hereafter named. Item. I give unto my soon Niccolus Day all that Tract of land at Gunpowder called or knowne by the name Willam the Conqueror to the said Niccolus Day and his heirs for ever and for want of such heirs after his decease to be deemed the proper right Intraitt of my second soon knowne by the name of Edward Day to him and his heirs for ever. Item. I give unto my soon Niccolus Day all that part of my stock of hogs that is of his proper Mark and also I give to my daughter Sarah Day all that part of my stock of hogs that is of her proper Mark. Item. I give unto Obidiah Richitt six young Sows with Pig or Pigs by thires sides. also I give unto Wallter Pardus fore young sow Shoates. Item. I give unto my two youngest daughters Elizeboth Day and Dinah Day all that Tract of Land wheron I now live to be equely divided betwene them after the death of my loving wife Sarah Day to them and their heirs for ever, as for my pars small Estate I doe ordaine it to be Equely divided between my wife and my five Children and lastly I doe hereby constitute and ordaine and appoint my above said true and lawfull wife Sarah Day to be my sole and onely Executrix of this my last will and Testament as witnesses my hand and seale the day and year above Titten. First I bequeath my Soule into the hands of Almighty God my maker hoping that through the meritoris death and passion of Jesus Christ my onely Saviour and Redeemer to receive freepardon and forgiveness of all my sins, and as for my body to be buried in Cristians buriall at the descretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned. I bequeath and give my eldest son William my black Hore called Michifhall and one Gun and I give unto my son Clark the other of my Gunes. I bequeath and order that all my goods and Chattles shall be equally divided amongst my four Children William and Clark Sara and Lucrela. I bequeath and order all my lands and Plantations to be equally divided amongst my four Children William Clark Lucrela and Sara, when my son Equely amongst them every child a part alike and I order that my daughter Sara shall live one my dwelling & plantation and have the wife of the same untill her brother William come to age. also I order if my daughter Lucrela marries to have the plantation that John Parker now liveth on unto her brother Clark comes to age. I make and constitute and ordaine Benjamin Smith and Henry Jackson to be Executors of this my last will and Testament revoking all wills and Testaments whatsoever but this.
