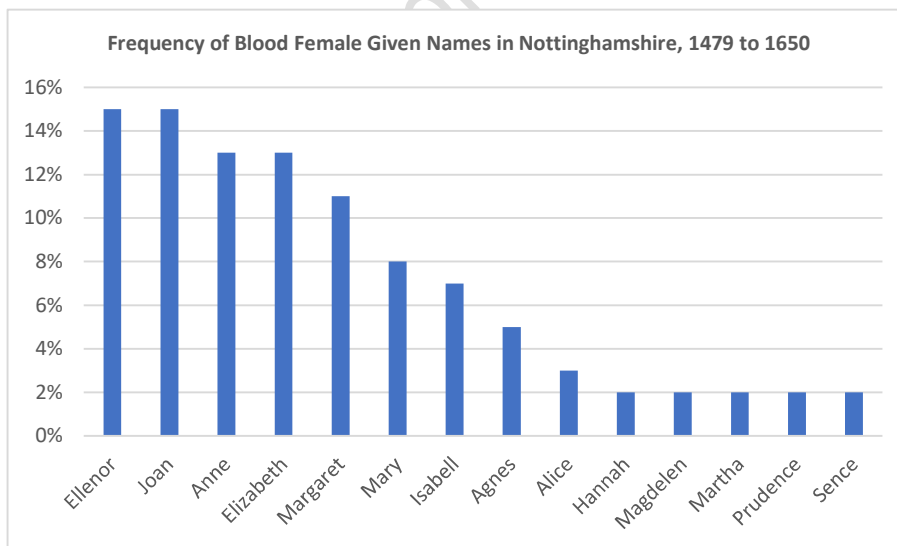
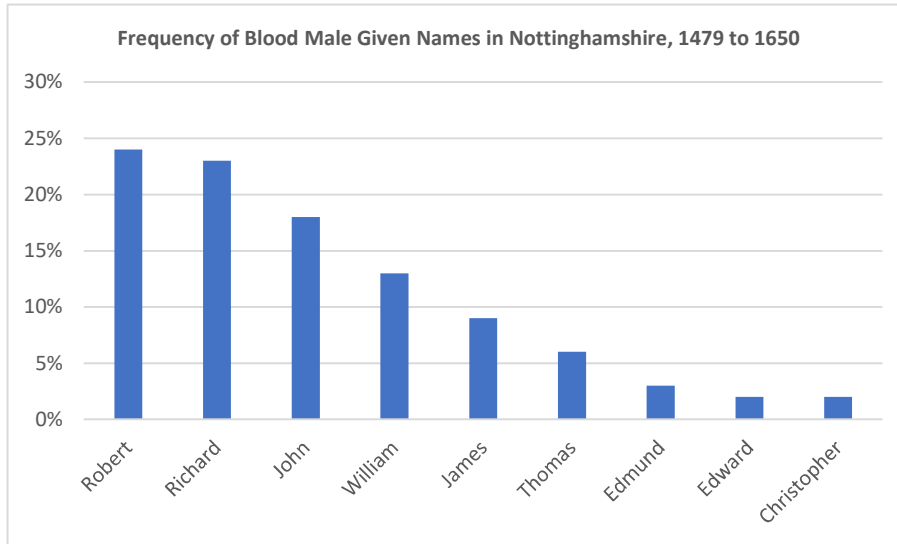


# Blood Given Names in Nottinghamshire

## -- 1479 to 1650 --

Results are sorted by frequency of male vs. female given names in 153 records of Bloods across Nottinghamshire.



Note 1: Ellenor is a catchall category for a large number of related female given names, to include Ellena, Ellinor, Ellener, Ellenor, Elnor, and Elnor. Even though the Ellenor-derived names were of a different origin from the Elnor-derived names, by the 16<sup>th</sup> century their spellings had become hopelessly entangled.

Note 2: Joan is a catchall for Jone, Joane, Joanne, and Johan (which could be a latinized form of either John or Joan/Joanne).
