1955; Henrietta Boyd Dalbey; Services are pending at the Street and Draper funeral home for Mrs Henrietta Boyd Dalbey, 55, a pioneer city resident who died at her home 2714 NW 35th, late Thursday after suffering a stroke. Mrs Dalbey had made her home here since she was 2 years old. Her father, the late AW Boyd, was one of the founders of the Oklahoma Hardware Co and served as an early-day president of the chamber of commerce here. Her husband, Carl S Dalbey, who survives, is the vice-president of the Oklahoma Hardware Co. Other survivors include two daughters, Mrs Ray Lockney, Enid and Miss Emma Leah Dalbey, of the home; Mrs Norman E Reynolds, Sr her sister 4421 N Walker and two grandchildren.
