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Foreword

For many years information relative to the Willhoite family was found in two source books - 1) The GAAR Genealogy by John Wesley Gaar and John Calhoun Gaar and 2) The Wilhoit Family by John Connie Willhite, Jr., which was published in the October 1971 issue, No. 13, of the Germanna Record, the official publication of the Memorial foundation of the Germanna Colonies in Virginia, Inc., Culpeper, VA. Those two volumes represent many years of careful research, and all the descendants of Johann Michael Willheit (regardless of the spelling of the name) owe a debt of gratitude to the authors, though some of the material has been found by later researchers to have been in error, principally the place of origin of the family in Germany and the relationship of the four early male Willheits of Virginia to each other.

In 1983 the Pennsylvania German Society of Birdsboro, PA published the first of two works by Annette Kunselman Burgert based on her readings of German church records via Latter Day Saints films. That volume concentrated on the Kraichgau area of Germany and included records from the village of Schwaigern. Mrs. Burgert was concerned with connecting information found in those German church books with known immigrants who came through Philadelphia in the 18th Century.

More recently the APG Quarterly, the official publication of The Association of Professional Genealogists, published in the Fall and Winter, 1986 issues The Ancestry of Johann Michael Willheit, Virginia Immigrant by Johni Cerny and Gary Zimmerman based on their readings of LDS films of the parish registers of The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Schwaigern. Thanks to the efforts of those three researchers Willhoites are now able to bridge the Atlantic Ocean and trace their origins back more than four hundred years to their ancestors in the village of Schwaigern, Germany.

The first part of this work is comprised of nine genealogical charts which begin in the second decade of the twentieth century and trace back in time maternal and paternal lines as far as the authors have been able to extend them. The second part is concerned with the direct line of the family from John Willhoite (1745-1837), a "soldier in the Revolution." Insofar as limitations of time and space permit, as much information concerning collateral lines as the writers have been able to garner in the last twenty-five years of reading and searching are presented. The third part is concerned with the maternal lines.

The index contains the names of 1) all individuals in the ancestor charts; 2) numerous direct descendants of John and Lucy Willheit; and 3) many other "Willhoites" regardless of the spelling used by the individual, which in frontier days sometimes varied even among siblings. Though John and Lucy used the spelling Willheit, some of their sons, as well as many of John's brother Joel's numerous descendants who lived in Owen County, KY also, adopted the "Willhoite" spelling as used on the tombstones of John and Lucy.

It is now generally accepted by most researchers that those of the name in America using a terminal consonant "t" in the spelling are of Johann Michael's line, and those using a "d" belong to the family of Johann Michael's first cousin Frederick Willhide who arrived in Phil-

adelphia in 1732 and settled in Maryland.

The sources from which the Willhoite data were gathered include:

- 1) U.S. censuses of 1790, 1810, 1840, 1850, 1860, 1870, 1880 and 1900;
- 2) Pension papers of Civil War and Revolutionary War veterans;
- 3) County Court Records including marriages, wills, deeds, etc.;
- 4) Church records;
- 5) Tombstones;
- 6) Family Bibles;
- 7) Information from family members; and
- 8) Early tax records.

If specific documentation is desired, the sources listed below have been found cooperative:

- 1) Censuses: state libraries and state genealogical societies;
- 2) Marriages and Wills: county clerks' offices, church records (particularly before 1800);
- 3) Deaths: published indexes of cemeteries of the area, undertakers' reports (for some counties published and in city libraries);
- 4) Place of birth: censuses beginning with 1850;
- 5) Relationships: censuses of 1880 and 1900; and
- 6) Date of birth: Age only until the 1880 census, month and year from 1880; some 1900 censuses include additional information including the year of marriage.

An invaluable resource has been and continues to be the faithful correspondents, too numerous to list, who were willing to exchange Willhoite and maternal lines data. Notable among these is Frederick Westcott, a Willhoite on two lines as well as a Furnish, whose help in writing and translating German materials, as well as his frequent, prolific, and well-documented research are hereby acknowledged with gratitude.

Since most, if not all of the women who bravely married Willhoite men were descended from families who came to America three or four generations prior to the Willhoites, much more research has been published regarding them and much more documentation is available. The authors have here recorded only the direct lines down to the jointure of each to the Willhoite line.

Of these, proofs are supplied when known. Of the Ezell and Duncombe lines, little has been proved prior to the marriages of these lines into the Willhoite family. The hypothetical (though strongly suspected) Duncombe line is recorded simply to give clues which might act as pieces in a puzzle. The same is true regarding the Ellis family and the mystery of Robert Durham.

Any proof that readers can supply to either prove or disprove these lines will be much appreciated and added to any revised printings. And of course, this also applies to the Willhoite family, particularly Achilles' (2.1) line.

That inscription reads

"JOHN WILLHOITE, a soldier in the war of the Revolution died Feb. 17, 1837 aged 95 years"

His wife, LUCY STAPP WILLHOITE, lies beside him, and her stone reads

"Lucy, wife of J. Willhoite,
died March 28, 1828
aged 81 years"

For their preservation and protection these two grave markers have been moved by the Owen County Historical Society from the Willhoite Cemetery North of Monterey to the Owenton Cemetery.

The WILLHOITES were of the Lutheran faith, and LUCY was of a family who were strongly Baptist. They came to Kentucky in 1792 and stayed a short time at Forks of Elkhorn with the Stapp family and with the Vawters, who were the in-laws of Achilles Stapp, LUCY's brother, before proceeding to the area that was to be their home.

At least three William Rutledges b.c. 1795 in North Carolina have been researched, yet none of them can be proved to be our William. Now it remains to be seen whether, by closely tracing the Ezells and Buchannons who lived near and married the Rutledges in Arkansas, his antecedents may be proved.

JOHNSON

The earliest proven Johnson ancestor is the Revolutionary War soldier William Johnson. There are at least eight soldiers with that name from VA who served, but fortunately only one who died in Owen Co., KY. He served in the Virginia Militia in 1779 and 1780.

EZELL

It was at first believed that NANCY EZELL RUTLEDGE was descended from Mason Ezell, who came to America from France with Lafayette in the summer of 1777. It is now almost certain that this is not true, for there is much evidence that she is from an Ezell line that predates the War of the Revolution by at least one hundred years.

Three of the grave markers in Chant Cemetery, Scott County, AR have these inscriptions:

Family tradition is that the Ezells came from Middle Tennessee. It is true there were numerous Ezells in that area dating from the early 19th Century. However, careful research by many individuals has failed to find a Nancy with a date of birth calculated from the information given in the 1880 AR census (circa 1846) or the one on her tombstone, 1844. Nor has a male Ezell been found who 1) was the right age, 2) had a given name which to the census enumerator might have sounded like K. J., and 3) had a given name which sounded enough like Michell to warrant its use on his grave marker. In the 1880 census K. J. is the name listed for Nancy's father, Jeff Rutledge's father-in-law. Since Micajah comes close to filling the three requirements listed above, several researchers believe it to be the name of Nancy's father.

Early Virginia, South Carolina, and North Carolina families moving West usually travelled in groups for safety reasons and also because families in the group were connected by marriage. For those reasons and also for the obvious one of the similarity of given names the family delineated below is believed to be Nancy's:

~~If Asa C. is Timothy's son and Mary L. his daughter-in-law, as seems to be the case, Timothy's age is wrong for him to be 6th generation Timothy. If this Micajah is generation 6, his age is wrong. It is quite possible that there is a generation before Timothy listed in the 1850 AR, Independence Co. census about which we know nothing; however, there is substantial evidence that this is Nancy's family.~~

Independence County is just South of Lawrence County and not more than ten miles from Strawberry Township where Temple Rutledge and Nancy H. Buchhannon were married in 1851. Did Buchhannons other than Ezell wives travel West from NC to TN with this family?

DUNCOMBE

The ancestors of ELIZABETH DUNCOMBE have not been proved. It is thought that she was of the Duncombe family whose first records are in Lancaster Co., VA and then in Stafford Co., VA - a frequent migration route to Orange Co., VA where Elizabeth married in 1773. That family is:

One respected genealogist believes that Nancy was the daughter of William Ellis who left a will in 1793 in Woodford County naming wife Agee and children Susannah Clark, John Ellis, William Ellis, Thomas Ellis, Charles Ellis, Hezekiah Ellis, Phoebe McDonald, Polly Ellis, Nancy Ellis, Betty Ellis, and John Ellis.

It would appear that this Nancy was one of three unmarried daughters in 1793; and since Nancy Willhoite was married in 1801, William may be her father.

Another excellent genealogist believes that Nancy's father was Jesse Ellis, Sr. He left a will in Woodford Co. 8 Oct 1818 naming son Moses Ellis and daughter Sally Ellis. He is known to have had a son Jesse, Jr. Why is he not named? Was a daughter Nancy also not named?

Heirs of Eleazor Ellis, who died 1838 leaving 110 acres on Severn Creek (where Nancy and Tobias lived), were Polly Ellis, William Ellis, Martha Ellis, Reuben A. Ellis, James F. Ellis, Nancy Ellis, Permelia Ellis, Mahala Ellis, and Mary Elizabeth Ellis. Note the use of Ellis for all daughters. It seems unlikely that not even the eldest girls would not have been married. Because of this and the location Eleazor may have been Nancy's father. Nancy and Tobias had granddaughters named Mahala and Permelia.

Nancy and Tobias had sons named Obediah and Israel, names not previously used in the Willhoite family. There were records in Woodford Co. before 1795 for Obediah and Jezreel (Israel). Were these relatives of Nancy?

PROOF

- 1st Generation - ROBERT DURHAM's will states that money is owed him by the Fredericksville Company. This was a foundry or furnace which had been opened in 1730. His great grandson Milton Stapp of Madison Co., IN states in his memoirs that Robert was an Englishman who "owned a foundry in PA." The only Durham Furnace in Pennsylvania at that time was in Bucks County. Remains of it can still be seen there. The manager and engineer of the furnace was named Robert Durham. It may be that, as it bore his name, he was also the owner.

This Robert Durham was the inventor and builder of the Durham Boat according to Bucks Co. history. It was built to carry the products of the furnace down river to Philadelphia (actually down the canal which still exists) and bring back goods from Philadelphia. What is historically significant is that it was a Durham Boat which carried General Washington and his troops across the Delaware that fateful night during the Revolution. The records of this Robert are not found in PA after Hannah's father's records begin to appear in Spottsylvania Co., VA. This could mean that the Pennsylvania Robert and the Virginia Robert are one and the same.

Robert's will has an unusual wording which is "my legal wife" regarding Agnes. Since Bucks Co., PA was and is a stronghold of Quakers, marriages outside the Quaker Community were frowned upon. It may be that the young couple did not have the blessing of the "meeting", and for that reason left PA. For some reason he wanted it known that Agnes was his wife in the eyes of the law.

Hannah and Ann were quite young when he died, for a guardian was appointed for Hannah ten years after her father's death. It appears it was a guardianship of property rather than person, as Anthony Gol-

ston. her guardian, posted a bond of 500 pounds sterling, indicating a fairly large inheritance for one child.

2nd Generation - The will of JOSHUA STAPP, Sr. names his children and also grandchildren Achilles and LUCY STAPP, who married JOHN WILHOUT.

4th Generation - HANNAH's marriage to JOSHUA STAPP, Jr. is proved by a petition regarding the settlement of the estate of JOSHUA STAPP, Jr. who died intestate in Adair Co., KY. The petition named the children of Joshua, Jr. including LUCY and JOHN WILHITE. Petition dated 11 Sep 1819 is found in Adair Co., KY Court Order Book C.


