

Stranraer 27 July 1797 This day John M Donald Soldier <sup>(41)</sup> in the Ross Shire Fencibles, and Sara M Donald from the Isle of Skye after Proclamation and no objections being offered were lawfully married.

Stranraer 21 August 1797 This day James M. Nechan and Marion Ross both in this Town after proclamation & no objections being offered were lawfully married.

Stranraer 7 Decr. 1797 This Day Peter Millar Smith and Helen M William both in this parish after proclamation and no objections being offered were lawfully married.

Stranraer 28 Decr. 1797 This day Andrew Turnbull (art Wright) and Agnes Lither after proclamation and no objections being offered were lawfully married.

Stranraer 24 April 1798 This Day Thomas Mean Shoemaker, and Helen M Musters both in this Town after proclamation were lawfully married.

Stranraer 6 May 1798 This day Thomas Clerk Esq<sup>r</sup> of Kings County Kingsdown of Ireland and Miss Margaret Beach Tippin after Proclamation and no objections being offered were lawfully married before these Witnesses Captain Maxwell of the 23 Regiment of Dragoons and James Carmichael School Master in Stranraer.

Stranraer 7 May 1798 This day Sergeant John M Millan of the Gordon Fencibles and Janet Ross lawful Daughter of William Ross in Stranraer after proclamation of Banns and no objections being offered were lawfully married.

Stranraer 9 June 1798 This day Messrs James Merchant in this Town and Josiah Stewart in Parish of Sorbie gave in their Names for Proclamation in order to Marriage being accordingly proclaimed were married.

Stranraer 2 July 1798 This day M Thomas Kerr Surgeon and Miss Margaret Stewart lawful Daughter of John Stewart Esq<sup>r</sup> Fullinwea Ireland after proclamation were lawfully married.
