MeKay Rocords, Raeford, N. C.
On the farm of S.J. Cameron, some eight or ten miles north from Raeford, there exists an old graveyard, which is of considerable historical importance. This is the farm owned and occupiod by Alexander McKay during the var of the Revolution.
