Children of John and Lois Kersey Beals: (or Bales). Beals, Charles, Ezra. Walter, Estelle. Elizabeth Masten, b. in Delaware 1758, d. in Stokes Co., N. C. 10-20-1849, aged 91 yrs. Elizabeth m. Richard Clampett in Delaware and came to N. C. about 1784 or 1785. Richard, d. in 1820. Children mentioned in his will were: Clampett: John, George, Ezekiel, William, Dinah, m. a Beeson, Matthias, Richard. Elizabeth, m. Nicholas Talley. After Richard's death, his widow Elizabeth, m. 11-7-1821 Reuben Shields, whose 1st wife was Mary Moore. They came to Stokes Co., N. C. from Delaware about 1778. Children of Reuben Shields and wife Mary Moore: Shields, Abel, m. Sarah Saunders and went to Ind. Susannah, m. Isaac Teague (N.C.). Jerusha, m. 2-18-1802 Barnett Idol (N. C.). Benjamin, m. ---- Fields. Samuel, m. Hannah Johnson (Ind.) Mary, m. David Roberson, (N.C.) Elizabeth, m. Isaac Payne, (N.C.). William, m. Rebecca Roberson. Lydia, m. Isaac Beeson, went to Iredell Co. and then to Ind. Col. John McGee was a commissioned English officer and was recommended for Captain of Militia in 1755. Col. John McGee came to America with his parents. His mother died on voyage over and was buried at sea. Col. McGee and his father lived first in Maryland, later coming to N. C. a widower with two children: McGee, Samuel, m. Rebecca Busick. Nancy, who became the 2nd wife of Robert Lindsay. In 1759 Col. John McGee married Martha McFarlane of Orange Co. At this time he lived on Sandy Creek in what was then Orange Co. later Guilford, and still later Randolph Co. Randolph was formed from Guilford Co. in 1779. Children of Col. John and Martha McFarlane McGee: McGee, Jane (called Jean), b. 1760, d. 1835, m. John Welborn. Susannah, b. 1762, m. Elisha Mendenhall. William, b. 1765, d. 1828, m. Anna King. He was a Presbyterian

Shields (1760-1861) Reuben Shields married Mary Moore in Delaware and came to North Carolina about 1784 and settled about three miles south of Kernersville.
