

Mayflower Descendant Lineage

Thomas Rogers and his son Joseph Rogers were passengers on the Pilgrim ship Mayflower which arrived in what is now Plymouth, Massachusetts in 1620. Thomas was a signer of the Mayflower Compact, but Joseph was too young to sign. Thomas died in the winter of 1620/21.

As a descendant of Thomas Rogers and Joseph Rogers, I submitted an application to the General Society of Mayflower Descendants with supporting documentation. In order to be a member of the society, one needs to provide birth, death, and marriage documentation for one's Mayflower lineage.

I submitted my application in September 2018, and it was approved by the society's historian general and governor general in December 2018. This document contains copies of the membership certificate that I received and the approved application excluding my personal information showing the types of documentation submitted. It does not include the supporting documentation submitted because it is 86 pages long.

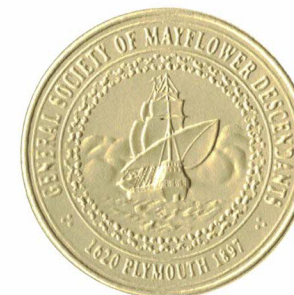
