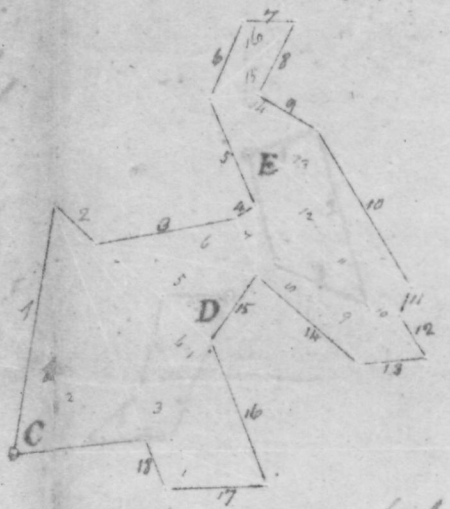


Harford County I do hereby certify that I have surveyed and carefully laid out for Edward Leonard a tract or Parcel of the Reserve Land in Harford County Beginning at North eighty degrees West two perches distant from four Bounded White Oak Saplings Standing on the East Side and within five perches of the forks of a Small Branch that Empties into Deer Creek Between the Great and Falling Branches and South Eighty Degrees East eight perches & are half distant from the end of the first line of a tract of Land called The Millers Fancy and Running thence past bounding with said tract North eighty degrees West One hundred & thirty five perches to a bounded Spanish Oak Near the top of a hill called the North Hill thence North East thirty one perches to a bounded White Oak Sapling on a hill on the North side of the Great Branch thence North ten degrees West Seventy four perches North thirty four degrees West twelve perches South sixty eight degrees West Sixty perches West North West forty four perches to a bounded Hickory Lion thence North twenty seven perches to two bounded White Oak Saplings in a Hollow thence South Sixty three degrees East forty four perches North thirty one degrees East thirty six perches North Sixty degrees East Ninety six perches to a bounded Spanish Oak Sapling in the North sixty seven degrees West fifty perches line of a tract of Land called Mabormicks Tract thence bounding on said tract Reversely the two following Courses (viz.) South Sixty seven degrees East sixteen perches to a bounded Black Oak on the Side of a Hill thence North fifty nine degrees East twenty six perches till it intersects the South four degrees East One Hundred and Six perches line of a tract of Land called Hamplays Deputees thence with said line South four degrees East thirty four perches to a bounded White Oak at the end thence South forty two degrees West Seventy two perches to a bounded White Oak Sapling thence South East by East forty two perches North Seventy degrees East eighty three perches to two bounded Chestnut Saplings Near the main Road Leading past John Cox's Mill on Little Creek to Baltimore thence Bounding on said Road South two degrees East fifty two perches thence South Sixty seven degrees West twenty eight perches And thence by a Straight line to the beginning containing & laid out for one and Spittle field April 17th 1787
