I. The first of the name in Virginia is "William Bacon,Gent" who Patented in Northumberland Co.,Va., and died there about 1680. He left his property to his wife,Margaret, and mentions no children.

II. Colonel Nathaniel Bacon.b. Aug.29"1620; d. Mar.16"1692; knighted XXXVII.1658; lived at Kings Creek, York Co.;Councillor for 40 years and Acting Governor of Virginia; Devised his property to his natuses: Elizabeth Sherry and Abigail Smith(See Will in N.E.Gen.Hist Reg. XXXVII.p.194);wife of Maj. Lewis Burwell, of Gloucester Co. Va. and daughter of Anthony Smith and his wife, Martha Bacon;.

"Col. Nathaniel Bacon was buried in York County, and in 1852 his grave was opened and the memorial slab examined; it bore the Coat of Arms indicating the distinguished social position of the deceased, it bore also the following inscription,viz: "Here lyeth interred ye body of Nathaniel Bacon,Esq., whose descent was from the ancient House of ye Bacons, who was Auditor of Virginia and President of ye Honourable Council of State and Commander in Chief for the County of York, having been of ye Councell for above 40 years and having always discharged ye offices in which he served with great fidelity and loyalty to his Prince, who departed this life ye 16th. of March 1692, in ye 73rd. year of his life."-T.M.Green.

There was a Sir Thomas Lyddall,d.1627, m.Bridget Woodward, daughter of George Woodward and his wife; Elizabeth Honiwood, (who was sister to Martha Honiwood, married Rev.James Bacon), she married 2"Rev. Robert Peake,Rector of Hingham, in Co. Norfolk.

In the will dated May 15"1666, of Sir Robert Peake,"Citizen and Goldsmith of London", a legacy of £300. is left to "my cousin and sometime servant, George Lyddall, in Virginia Gent." It is probable that George Lyddall of Virginia was fourth son of Sir Thomas Lyddall. IV. CAPTAIN EDMUND BACON, "was doubtless a relative, but could not have been a son of Nathaniel Bacon Jr., "the Rebel", as he was a grown man and Captain ten years after "the Rebel's" death". -W. & M. Quarterly. He had a son:

In the Docket of the General Court, preserved in the Ludwell MSS. in the Virginia Historical Society, there is this title of a suit: "William Clepton the younger, and Joyce, his wife, vs. John Bacon, per John Turner, Executor of Frances Izard, deceased."

In one branch of the Bacon Family in Virginia tradition says that V.-John Bacon, was the son of Nathaniel Bacon, the "Rebel," that he was adopted by Mrs. Frances Izard, and the above land known as "The Brooke" willed to him, and from him descended to #563 Captain Izard Bacon. This does not agree with the belief of the Virginia Historical Society but does agree with the traditions of the whole Bacon family in Virginia, Kentucky, South Carolina, and Georgia. The older slaves brought from Virginia by #111. John Bacon, to Kentucky in the latter part of the XVIIIth Century often told John Bacon's children that "Nathaniel Bacon, "The Rebel" was their ancestor; that he was poisoned by the treachery of friends of Governor Berkeley and that as Berkeley had offered a reward for him "dead or alive", when he died his slaves buried him in the night, in James River, and weighted his coffin with stones that his body might be secure from the vengeance of Berkeley."
