Joseph Dills marriage bond, from the archives N.C., dated March 1787 to Mary Wright daughter of Isaac Wright showing both of Guilford County N.C.

Later Census records show their children born in S.C. until Marvel M. Dill who was born in 1809 in N.C. No record of where Harriet and Amandy were born but probably was Tenn.

During the settlement (1826) of Joseph Dills estate by Isaac Dill there is an entry showing the sale of Joseph Dills land in S.C. or some part of it, to some of the Dills who were still living near Spartanburg, S.C.

The names of his children and dates of birth copied from Joseph Dills Day Book. He seemed to have had some sort of disability as he mentioned in his will to give Patty a slave her freedom as she had been so much help in his "affliction". Patty is shown in 1850 census as being born in S.C. and 65yrs of age. See Freedom papers in back.
