 part and Walter Bosly of the same County planter of the other part Witneseth that the said
 John Greer for a valuable consideration by him in hand already rec^d theret^e whereof he doth
 hereby acknowledge & thereof to every part thereof doth hereby acquit & exonerate & discharge the
 aforesd Walter Bosly his heirs & assigns by these presents hath bargained given granted sold
 eased & confirmed by these presents doth bargain give grant sell alien enfeoff & confirm
 unto the said Walter Bosly his heirs & assigns forever Seventy five acres of land being part of a
 greater tract called Arthurs choice lying & being situate in Balt^r Cty. and on the south side
 of a branch of Gunpowder river called Birds river beginning at a red Oak standing on the P.
 River running from the said Oak bounding on the river E. N. E. fifty three perches by a line
 drawn South east from the end of the east North E. line unto the woods. for length three
 hundred perches then by a line drawn West South West fifty three perches then by a straight line
 North North West to the first mentioned bounds con^r Seventy five acres together with all houses
 fences buildings woods underwoods timber or timberlike trees waters and water courses
 easents and privileges profits rights members & appurtenances to the sd land belonging or
 any ways appertaining & the reversion & reversionary remainder and remainders rents -
 issues & profits thereof and all the estate right title & interest of him the sd Iohn Greer his
 heirs exec^r or adm^r of or to the same or any part thereof to have & to hold the said -
 Seventy five acres of Land so as above sd bargained given granted to be with the apur-
 tenances & every part & parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest claim or demand
 whatsoever of the sd Greer or any of his or theirs whatsoever in & to the same into the said
 Walter Bosly his heirs & assigns to the sole use & proper behoof of the sd Bosly his heirs &
 assigns for ever free & clear & freely & clearly exonerated & discharged of and from all manner
 of rents titles trouble charge or incumbrance whatsoever the rents & service which -
 hereafter shall become due thence payable to the chief Lord of the fee of whom the premises are
 held only excepted foreprized and the said Iohn Greer for himself his heirs exec^r adm^r doth
 covenant to and with the said Bosly his heirs & assigns that the said Iohn Greer at the time
 of the sealing and delivery of these presents is & stands lawfully seized in his demesne
 in the above said Seventy five acres of land & every part & parcel thereof that he hath
 good right title full power & authority to grant sell and convey the above said land
 premises with all its rights members and appurtenances unto the above said Walter
